

## Purpose

The Annex is a collaborative project of Providence College (with leadership from its Feinstein Institute for Public Service), the Smith Hill Community Development Corporation and many individuals and groups with interest in Providence's Smith Hill neighborhood. The Annex is a space where the Providence College campus and the Smith Hill community come together to start conversations leading to mutual understanding and collaboration.

The Annex is premised on an idea captured by writer Meg Wheatley in her book, *Turning to One Another: Conversations to Restore Hope to the Future*:

...we can change the world if we start listening to one another again. Simple, honest, human conversation...What would it feel like to be listening to each other again about what disturbs and troubles us? About what gives us energy and hope? About our yearnings, our fears, our prayers, our children?

Rich, authentic conversation and the relationships that come out of them often lead to action, and we hope that The Annex will be full of both conversation and action. The college will use this space for a variety of community based programming activities that are primarily educational and learning based. The space is expected to be used for neighborhood-based classes, meetings of PC and community groups and community based programming. The space will also be used as a site for developing "community action research" projects across the curriculum - research projects jointly designed and implemented by community and college partners, and intended to contribute to the development of the neighborhood. The space will also serve as a site for neighborhood speak-outs on various concerns, and for reflection opportunities. Overall, these programs at a neighborhood site deliberately designed to be shared with and hospitable to residents creates the potential for qualitatively different, and deeper, relationships. The focus of the project is relationship development and dialogue more than on program development and/or delivery.

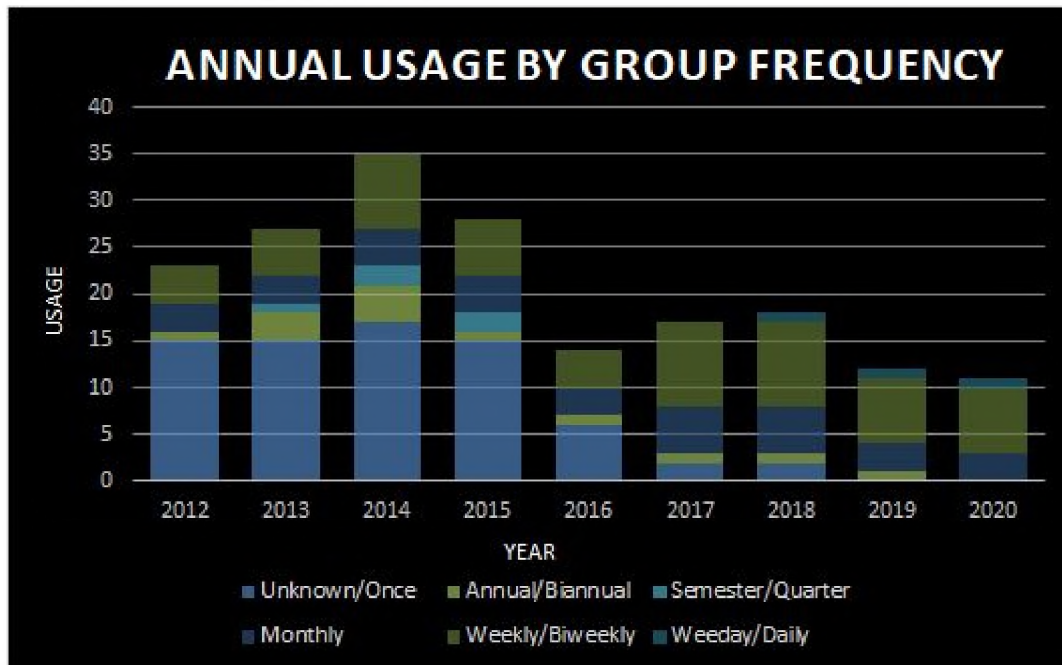

#### Summary of Continued Usage (2012-2020)



During the Annex's first year of operations, it attracted approximately 15 groups for one-off events, 3 for annual/biannual events, 3 for monthly events, and 4 for weekly/biweekly events. The following years saw a steady decline in the number of groups utilizing the space for one-off events, especially starting in 2016, when this figure was reduced by nearly 50%. Meanwhile, the groups utilizing the space on an annual basis remained quite steady throughout the years, with slight peaks in 2013 and 2014. However, the decrease in groups utilizing the space for one-off or annual/biannual events was contrasted by the increase in groups utilizing the space on a monthly, weekly/biweekly, and weekday/daily basis. The increase in these usage frequencies was most prominent during 2014, and then again in 2017. Following this period, the usage became more consistent and most of the groups utilizing the space are regular partners. This demonstrates that the Annex has become a space for specific community groups in the Providence (and more generally, Rhode Island) area.

Unfortunately, like so many other community-engaged projects and resources, the PC/Smith Hill Annex was upended in March 2020. As the pandemic became a reality in Rhode Island and on the Providence College Campus, the Annex closed in accord with public health and college policies; every day that we pass, unused space serves as one small reminder of the social isolation so many of us are experiencing.

Prior to March, the Annex was cranking along in its 8th year of operation, riding on the good work of co-leader Kate Corwin, a graduate student in the MBA program. Kate had been deeply involved with the Smith Hill community while she was an undergraduate and utilized her relationships to encourage and support use of the Annex. She helped make the Annex's mission materialize: this simple 1,000 square space is offered for free to campus and community groups, and exists for the express purpose of encouraging conversations that bring hope to the future.
